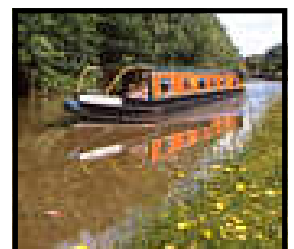
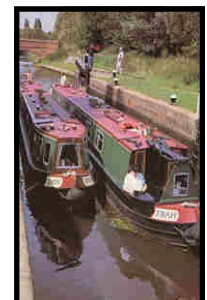

 England	The largest boating region - for narrowboats is England. Here you cruise the canals created in the 18th century to move goods built at the time of the Industrial Revolution.  Wales	Llangollen Canal - The Llangollen Canal is arguably the most beautiful canal on the whole English canal system and also boasts the striking 1007ft Pontcysyllite Aqueduct.
